

MOBILE PHONE CODE OF CONDUCT SEPTEMBER 2020

- Mobile Phones should be switched off in class unless the class teacher gives permission to use for the purpose of the learning and teaching
- Mobile Phones should not be used in the corridors, toilets or changing areas —They can be used in the canteen, assembly hall and outdoors during break and lunchtime.
- Mobile Phones should not be used to contact home if you are unwell, you should present at the main office. A member of the office will contact home and next steps agreed.
- The school does not accept any responsibility for theft, loss or damage the phones are brought to school at your own risk.
- If any pupil is found to be breaching the Mobile Phone code of conduct the phone will be confiscated placed in an envelope and passed to the school office for you to collect at the end of the school day
- If there are repeated instances of Mobile Phone misconduct the phone will be confiscated, placed in an envelope, sent to the office for Parent/Carer to collect at the end of the school day.
- Any invasion of privacy including filming, recording individuals without permission will be passed to the Campus Police Officer.
